RE: CSI Review – 2015 Chapter 17 (OAC 4715-17-01)

On behalf of Lt. Governor Mary Taylor, and pursuant to the authority granted to the Common Sense Initiative (CSI) Office under Ohio Revised Code (ORC) section 107.54, the CSI Office has reviewed the abovementioned administrative rule package and associated Business Impact Analysis (BIA). This memo represents the CSI Office's comments to the Agency as provided for in ORC 107.54.

Analysis

The proposed rule package consists of one amended rule being reviewed by the Ohio State Dental Board pursuant to the five-year review requirement in statute. The rule package was submitted to the CSI Office, along with 18 other proposed Dental Board packages, on December 8, 2015 and the comment period was held open through January 4, 2016. No comments were received during this time.

The proposed rule sets forth the procedures for notification of regular and special meetings of the Board. Notification must include the time, place, and purpose of the meeting. The BIA states that the adverse impact associated with this rule is the \$14 annual fee or self-addressed stamped envelopes associated with an individual's request to be notified via US Postal Service. Any person may receive notification via e-mail at no cost by providing the Board with their e-mail address. No comments were received that the impacts are burdensome.

Therefore, after reviewing the proposed rule, the CSI Office has determined the purpose of the rule

is justified.

Recommendations

For the reasons discussed above, the CSI Office does not have any recommendations for this rule package.

Conclusion

Based on the above comments, the CSI Office concludes that the Ohio State Dental Board should proceed with the formal filing of this rule package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.
