Re: Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal Acknowledgment of CSI
Review of Proposed One-Call; Fire and Hazardous Material Incident Reporting at a
Shale Oil Processing Premise (OAC 1301:7-7-01)

The Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of State Fire Marshal (SFM), is in receipt of the CSI Review of the above-referenced rule package dated September 28, 2016. The review made no recommendations for changes and concluded that the rules should be filed with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review ("JCARR"). Therefore, the SFM will proceed with the formal filing of this rule package with JCARR.

Please note, that the SFM will make one non-substantive change to the rule before filing with JCARR. **Section 124.3.2 (Fire Incidents as a shale oil processing premise), Exception 1**, will be edited to conform with language contained in other exceptions in the rule. Currently, Exception 1 reads:

1. The immediate reporting of the incident would subject any person to a health hazard arising from the fire incident at a shale oil processing premise;

The language will be edited as follows:

1. The immediate reporting of the fire incident at a shale oil processing premise would subject any person to a health hazard arising from the fire incident at a shale oil processing premise;

This change will conform the language used in Exception 1 to the language found in Exceptions 2 and 3 in this same section. The variation in the language was noted during the CSI process and the change will be made to maintain consistency. No other changes will be made to the rule prior to it being filed with JCARR.
