Re:	PUCO Response –Household Goods Transportation Rules Contained in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:2-19

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Commission) issued a Finding and Order on April 27, 2016, adopting rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:2-19 for the transportation of household goods. On May 26, 2016, CSI issued a response memorandum to the Commission noting that the impacted business community for the rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:2-19 is the for-hire carriers that provide household goods moving services operating in intrastate and interstate commerce.

On May 27, 2016, OAM filed an application for rehearing of the Commission's Finding and Order adopting the rules. On June 15, 2016, the Commission issued its Entry on Rehearing granting in part and denying in part OAM's application for rehearing. In paragraph 16, the Commission granted OAM's request for rehearing related to the 60-day time limit for filing claims. In paragraph 14, the Commission denied OAM's request for rehearing related to the liability coverage for full replacement and limited liability coverage in Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-19-06.

Once CSI has completed your final review, the Commission will proceed and file these rules with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review.
