Update:

Rule 5160-15-14 now incorporates the following change:

1. Paragraph (B)(4), which requires a County Department of Job and Family Services (CDJFS) to confirm the validity of each Medicaid provider number and NPI, has been removed because not every CDJFS can meet this requirement. The change has no impact on businesses.
