Thank you for reviewing ODA's proposal to amend rules 173-3-01, 173-3-06.4, 173-3-06.5, and 173-3-07 of the Administrative Code, which will involve rescinding rules 173-3-06.4 and 173-3-06.5 of the Administrative Code and simultaneously replacing them with new rules of the same numbers.

Because CSIO recommended filing the rules with JCARR without requesting further amendments, ODA will now file these rules with JCARR, but in doing so will not use *shall* when referring to requirements outside of these rules and only use *shall* once per requirement. This will not substantively change the rules reviewed by CSIO and will not increase these rules' regulatory restrictions.
