Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) Chapter 4765-8 (*Certificate to Teach or Practice; Continuing Education*) and rule 4765-18-11 (*Reciprocity qualifications for a certificate to teach as an EMS instructor.*). The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) has received and read your reviews, recommendations, and conclusions.

In July 2021, the Division of EMS intends to formally file the rules and all required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR), the Ohio Legislative Service Commission (LSC), and the Secretary of State.

As noted in your memorandum dated June 17, 2021, EMS adopted a recommendation received from a stakeholder during the CSI public comment period. The amended rule 4765-8-07, with revisions made in paragraph (A)(1)(b), is attached and will be filed with JCARR.

The Division of EMS plans to conduct a public hearing pursuant to Revised Code 119.03 in August 2021. The Division of EMS anticipates final-filing the rules with an effective date in October 2021.
