Thank you for your review of the business impact analysis for Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.) Chapter 4766-1 (*Public notice of rule adoption, amendment, or rescission.*) and Chapter 4766-2 (*Ambulances*). The Ohio Department of Public Safety (ODPS), Division of Emergency Medical Services (EMS) has received and read your reviews, recommendations, and conclusions.

This month, the Division of EMS intends to formally file the rules and all required materials with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR), the Ohio Legislative Service Commission (LSC), and the Secretary of State.

The Division of EMS plans to conduct a public hearing pursuant to Revised Code 119.03 in January 2022. The Division of EMS anticipates final-filing the rules with an effective date in March 2022.
