Re: PUCO Response – Towing of motor vehicles (OAC 4901:2-22-01 through 4901:2-

22-07)

In Case No. 21-564-TR-ORD, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) is reviewing its rules in Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:2-22. These rules, which are required by R.C. 4921.25, concern the forfeiture and compliance orders. Prior to issuing the proposed rules, the PUCO held a workshop on June 29, 2021, to enable interested stakeholders to offer proposals for Staff's consideration. No stakeholders provided comments at the workshop.

Following a formal comment period, the PUCO issued a Finding and Order on January 12, 2022, approving the proposed rules as set forth in the order. On March 14, 2021, CSI replied to the PUCO, stating that CSI had no recommendations, and concluding that the PUCO should proceed with formal filing of the rules package with the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR). In light of CSI's conclusion, the PUCO will proceed and file these rules with JCARR.
