### **Consolidated Summary of Comments Received**

**Proposed Language - 4729-5-40(A):** We suggest modifying the language to read - A pharmacist licensed under Chapter 4729 of the Revised Code may administer, by injection, any of the following dangerous drugs as long as the dangerous drug that is to be administered has been prescribed by a physician and the individual to whom the dangerous drug was prescribed has an ongoing relationship with the physician, an advanced practice registered nurse practicing who has entered into a standard care arrangement with the physician, **or** a physician assistant who has entered into a supervision agreement with the physician **or a pharmacist in a consult agreement with a physician.**

**Proposed Language 4729-5-40 (B)(3):** We suggest modifying the language to read - Practice in accordance with a protocol that meets the requirements of paragraphs (F) and (G) of this rule **or in accordance with a consult agreement with a physician.**

### **Incorporated Comments into Rule(s)**

- The suggested language was not included in the rule. A pharmacist can already administer medications in accordance with a consult agreement, which is authorized under a different section of the ORC and OAC. This rule is intended to permit the administration of drugs where no such consult agreement exists, per ORC 4729.45.
