### **PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Ohio State Racing Commission will hold a public hearing for the purpose of accepting testimony on the proposed amended rule package containing rules found in Chapter 8, and Chapter 18 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

These rules discuss furosemide requirements in horse racing. These rules were reviewed in accordance with the requirements of Ohio Revised Code 119.03 and have been proposed as follows:

- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-8-01 titled Medication and Testing. This rule is being revised to eliminate aminocaproic acid on raceday, and only allow furosemide administration on the grounds of the permit holder.
- Ohio Administrative Code 3769-18-01 titled Medication and Testing. This rule is being revised to eliminate aminocaproic acid on raceday, and only allow furosemide administration on the grounds of the permit holder at extended pari-mutuel meets.

The Hearing will be held on:

**July 5, 2022 at 10:00 am**
