Pursuant to Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities hereby gives notice of its intent to rescind and adopt rules of the Administrative Code on a permanent basis on or about May 4, 2023, and to conduct a public hearing thereon. At this public hearing, the Department will accept verbal and/or written testimony regarding the proposed rule actions.

Persons unable to attend the public hearing may submit written comments regarding the proposed rule actions. Any written comments received on or before the public hearing date will be treated as testimony and made available for public review. Based on the required five-year review, two rules governing community capital

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assistance funds are being rescinded and replaced by new rules.

Rule 5123:1-1-01 (Community capital assistance funds - non-residential capital facilities) sets forth a process for the Department to make available community capital assistance funds to boards of county commissioners, county boards of developmental disabilities, and nonprofit corporations for the purchase, construction, and renovation of non-residential capital facilities. The rule is being rescinded and replaced by new rule 5123-1-01 of the same title. New rule 5123-1-01 reflects revisions to align wording with newer rules.

Rule 5123:1-1-17 (Community capital assistance funds - residential accessibility and renovation projects) sets forth a process for the Department to make available community capital assistance funds to county boards of developmental disabilities, governmental entities, and nonprofit corporations for residential accessibility and renovation projects. The rule is being rescinded and replaced by new rule 5123-1-05 of the same title. New rule 5123-1-05 reflects revisions to align wording with newer rules.

The rules are available for review at the <u>Register of Ohio</u> and at the <u>Department's</u> <u>website</u>. The rules are also available for review at each county board of developmental disabilities.
