The purpose of this rule making is to satisfy the five-year rule review requirements under section 106.03 of the Revised Code. The purpose of this chapter is to govern the procedure for all adjudication proceedings and other procedures relating to adjudications pursuant to Chapter 119. of the Revised Code, or any other statute or rule providing for adjudication proceedings before the agency.

The public comment period will run until January 8, 2024. A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will be holding an in-person and virtual public hearing on the rules on January 8, 2024, at Ohio EPA, Summer Conference Room, 50 W. Town St., Suite 700, Columbus, OH 43215, at 10:30 am. The in-person hearing will be at the same time and date and will be located at Ohio EPA, Suite 700, 50 W. Town Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. During the hearing, the public may submit written comments on the record about the proposed rules and, if participating in person, may provide comments verbally.

Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying.

Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.
