The Department of Education and Workforce is required under R.C. 3301.075 to adopt rules regulating the purchasing and leasing of data processing services and equipment for all local, exempted village, city, and joint vocational school districts and all educational service centers. Such rules shall include provisions for the establishment of an Ohio education computer network under procedures, guidelines, and specifications of the department of education and workforce. Amendments to these rules are to remove regulatory restrictions and update references from Ohio Department of Education to the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce.

# OAC Chapter 3301-10 School Enrollment for Domestic Violence Victims (1 rule)

OAC 3301-10-01 School enrollment for victims of domestic violence. (Amend)

The Department of Education and Workforce is required under R.C. 3313.64(F)(9) to adopt rules regarding the school enrollment of children who are with a parent under the care of a shelter for victims of domestic violence. Amendments to this rule are to update disclosure of enrollment procedures, remove regulatory restrictions, and update references from Ohio Department of Education to the Ohio Department of Education and Workforce.
