Legal Notice

The State Board of Education will hold a public hearing regarding the rule actions listed below, on May 13, 2024, at 9:00 a.m. at the State Board of Education, Third Floor, Room 3, 30 West Spring Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215.

OAC Chapter 3301-27-01 Qualifications to direct, supervise, or coach a pupil-activity program (1 Rule)

3301-27-01 Qualification to direct, supervise, or coach a pupil-activity program. (Amend)
The rule is being amended as a result of House Bill 33 of the 135th General Assembly to add student mental health training in compliance with section 3313.5318 of the Revised Code.

OAC Chapter 3302-24-04 Teacher Residency (1 Rule)

OAC 3302-24-04 authorizes the teacher residency program. Legislative changes allow unlimited attempts to pass the Resident Educator Summative Assessment, increases the window for submission, provides coaching to those who do not pass, and access to videos.

OAC Chapter 3302-24-21 Computer Science License for Industry Professionals (1 Rule)

Creates a teaching license for computer science industry professionals.

OAC Chapter 3302-24-09 Pre-Service Teacher Permit (1 Rule)

Requires anyone in an educator preparation program to obtain this permit before they can be in a PK-12 classroom. Enrolls the permit holder in the RAPBACK program. Allows the permit holder to substitute teach and be compensated.

OAC Chapter 3302-23-44 Temporary and Substitute Licenses (1 Rule)

Addresses the requirements to obtain and renew temporary substitute teaching license.

OAC Chapter 3302-24-18 Resident Educator License (1 Rule)

Changes the grade bands on a teaching license.

OAC Chapter 3302-24-19 Alternative Resident Educator Licenses For Teaching In Grades Pre-Kindergarten To Twelve (1 Rule)

Changes the license from k-12 to pk-12 and allows for the license to be renewed.
