STATE OF OHIO UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION REVIEW COMMISSION PUBLIC NOTICE OF HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Unemployment Compensation Review Commission intends to conduct a public hearing for the purpose of amending two (2) Ohio Administrative Code Sections:

- 4146-9-01, "Content of decisions and orders; sending by electronic means or mailing of decisions and orders; revision of decisions and orders; copies of decisions and orders." The Unemployment Compensation Review Commission proposes to amend this rule to reflect that copies of decisions of hearing officers (lower authority) and decisions and orders of the review commission (higher authority) are retained electronically by the review commission for the retention period, rather than physical copies being "kept on file at the office of the review commission."
- 4146-11-02, "Challenges." The Unemployment Compensation Review Commission proposes to amend this rule to eliminate using the nowdefunct advisory council to decide challenges to a commissioner. The proposed change is required because the advisory council was eliminated by the Sunset Committee in its most recent review. Challenges to a Commissioner will follow the same process as challenges to a hearing officer.

The Unemployment Compensation Review Commission shall hold a public hearing to receive and hear public comments on the proposed rules from **12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 24, 2025**, at the Rhodes Tower, 30 East Broad Street, 31st floor Review Commission Hearing Room, Columbus, Ohio 43215. Please check in with the lobby security. Any person affected by the proposed rule may present their comments in person, or in writing.
