Legal Notice

The State Board of Education will hold a public hearing regarding the rule actions listed below, on July 14, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. at the State Board of Education, Second Floor, Room 3, 30 West Spring Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215.

OAC Chapter 3302-20-03 Employment of non-licensed individuals with certain criminal convictions (1 Rule)

ORC 3319.39 requires the rules to specify circumstances under which the board or governing authority of a school or district may hire a person who has been convicted of certain offenses but who meets standards in regard to rehabilitation set by the state board.

OAC Chapter 3302-83-23 Employment of school bus and van drivers with certain criminal convictions (1 Rule)

Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3319.39 requires the Board to amend this rule to specify the offenses that disqualify a person for employment as a school bus or school van driver and establish rehabilitation standards for school bus and school van drivers.
