The member regulation, enforcement and arbitration functions of the New York Stock Exchange and the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. were merged into the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority in July, 2007. The reference to the "National Association of Securities Dealers" in the administrative rules is being amended to "Financial Industry Regulatory Authority."

Part two of the Form ADV includes information that investment advisers must disclose to clients. For investor protection, the amendment will require IA's to electronically file part two of the Form ADV with the Division via IARD.
