It is proposed to make the following changes to this rule:

Remove the language requiring a permit to fish on Lake La Su An Wildlife Area. The practice of issuing and requiring permits was discontinued in 2012.

Define areas at East Branch, LaDue and Mogadore reservoirs where persons cannot wade or fish from shore. These areas are in the proximity of dams. These reservoirs are owned by the City of Akron, this proposal is at their request.

Add language stating that external gas tanks are prohibited and that electric motors only are allowed at East Branch Reservoir, LaDue Reservoir and Mogadore Reservoir. These reservoirs are owned by the City of Akron, this proposal is at their request.

Add language to clarify that there is no bag limit for fish other than walleyes, muskellunge, largemouth and smallmouth bass, while at, on, or when returning from Pymatuning lake.
