## 1501:41-2-20 "Golden Buckeye Card/Silver Savers Passport" and "Therapeutic Passport" fees.

Persons who are Ohio residents and holders of a "Golden Buckeye Membership Card/Silver Savers Passport," issued by the Ohio department of aging, and persons who are holders of "Therapeutic Passports" issued by the division shall have reduced rates and fees on certain recreation facilities and related activities. The discounts for qualifying persons are as follows:

- (A) Camping fees. Fifty per cent off of the fees listed in rules 1501:41-2-11, 1501:41-2-13, and 1501:41-2-24 of the Administrative Code. This discount does not apply to weekend camping. For the purposes of this rule, a "weekend" is defined as Friday night and Saturday night.
- (B) Other state recreational facilities, equipment and services, and food service operations. At least ten per cent off of the regular charges. As used in this paragraph, "food service operations" means restaurants which are owned by the department at Hocking Hills, lake Hope, Malabar Farm, and Rocky Fork state park, or are part of a state park lodge. It does not include automatic vending machines, concession stands or snack bars.
