This rule is being proposed for amendment as part of a larger effort by the Department to distinguish in Chapter 173-6 of the Administrative Code between "rebates" and "discounts" in order to provide clarity to drug manufacturers who seek to integrate their means-tested discount programs with the Golden Buckeye Prescription Drug program.

Rule Content: This rule describes how administrators are to administer prescription drug programs for Golden Buckeye Program cardholders.

Proposed Changes: The rule is being amended to clarify the Department's intent in light of the definitions added to existing/proposed rule 173-6-02 of the Administrative Code; to require any administrator participating in the Golden Buckeye Program to use one hundred percent of any drug discounts it receives to reduce the prescription purchase costs of cardholders; to delete or replace the word "discount" wherever it is used inconsistent with the definition of "drug discount" in proposed new rule 173-6-02 of the Administrative Code.
