## 3301-25-03 One-year student monitor educational aide permit.

An initial one-year student monitor educational aide permit may be issued upon the request and recommendation of an employing superintendent of a city, <u>local eounty</u>, or exempted village, <u>or joint vocational school district</u>, <u>educational service center</u>, or <u>the governing authority administrative head</u> of a <u>chartered nonpublic nontax supported</u> school <u>or community school</u>, provided the <u>applicant is deemed to be of good moral character and the hiring authority superintendent submits evidence assures</u> that the applicant meets the following <u>minimum</u> requirements:

- (A) The applicant is a graduate of an approved high school or has a statement of high school equivalence in accordance with regulations prescribed by the superintendent of public instruction (education.ohio.gov); and -
- (B) The applicant <u>demonstrates the potential</u> <u>has shown sufficient promise of being able</u> to <u>profit benefit</u> from in-service training, and <u>agrees shall be willing</u> to participate in such training <u>as required by the hiring authority</u>.
