## **One-year student monitor educational aide permit.**

An initial one-year student monitor educational aide permit may be issued upon the request and recommendation of an employing superintendent of a city, <u>local county</u>, or exempted village, <u>or joint vocational school district</u>, <u>educational service center</u>, or <u>the governing authority</u> administrative head of a <u>chartered nonpublic nontax-supported</u> school <u>or community school</u>, provided the <u>applicant is deemed to be of good moral character and the hiring authority</u> superintendent submits evidence <u>assures</u> that the applicant meets the following minimum requirements:

- (A) The applicant is a graduate of an approved high school or has a statement of high school equivalence in accordance with regulations prescribed by the superintendent of public instruction (education.ohio.gov); and -
- (B) The applicant <u>demonstrates the potential</u> has shown sufficient promise of being able to profit <u>benefit</u> from in-service training, and <u>agrees</u> shall be willing to participate in such training <u>as required by the hiring authority</u>.
