- * Replace "claimant" with "injured worker".
- * Remove and replace "his/her" with plural pronouns.
- * Remove language discussing part-time care and cross-reference Ohio Administrative Code rule 4123-6-38.
- * Remove requirement that the services are necessary as a "direct" result of the allowed injury.
