**Requirements for admission to the examination for a
psychologist license.****RULE SUMMARY**

6. State the reason(s) for proposing (i.e., why are you filing,) this rule:

Requirements for admission to examination in OAC 4732-9-01 contain requirements for the supervised training experiences of licensure candidates. With the proposed rules relative to the use of telepsychology in the supervisory relationship, the proposed changes herein relate to the limitations on the use of telepsychology in the training of professional psychologists.

then summarize the content of the rule:

The first paragraph in (H) is simply a clarifier for those applying for licensure under the Board's grandparent law. Under (H)(5) it is proposed that telepsychology may only be used in the training of grandparented licensure candidates as a supplement to the required face-to-face supervision requirements. Rule (I)(1)(b)(vii), a current rule governing the pre-doctoral internship experience consistent with the use of telepsychology in so many words, is proposed to be replaced by the proposed definition of "telepsychology" and specifies that licensure candidates may only receive supervision via telepsychology as a supplement to the required face-to-face (in-person) supervision requirements. Similarly, under (I)(2)(c)(x), which relates to qualifying pre-internship doctoral program training experiences, the same change in language is proposed as detailed above. Finally, related to post-internship training, under (I)(2)(d), the same language proposed for the pre-internship and internship rules is proposed. There was no need to strike language in this rule because we had neglected to include that language when writing the original rule. In addition, we had neglected to retain a limit in this rule relative to the use of teaching and research experience toward the pre-licensure training hours (30% appears in the grandparent rule and is proposed to be added here at (I)(2)(d)(xi)(d)). The proposed amendments end with a reassertion that those under pre-licensure training supervision may only receive supervision via telepsychology as a supplement to the required face-to-face (in-person) supervision requirements. The Board judged that this issue is critical to the extent that the redundancy relative to this issue is necessary so that the issue is abundantly clear.
