## <u>4755-23-06</u> Biennial renewal of licensure.

- (A) Renewal of a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant license shall be in accordance with section 4755.46 of the Revised Code.
  - (1) The entire licensure renewal application, including any required forms, compliance with the continuing education requirement specified in rule 4755-23-08 of the Administrative Code, and payment of the renewal fee prescribed by rule 4755-24-04 of Administrative Code, shall be completed to satisfy the requirements of the renewal procedure.
  - (2) The licensure renewal application shall be mailed to the address on file with the board.
- (B) Persons whose last name begins with any letter of the alphabet from A to L shall renew their license by the thirty-first day of January in each even-numbered year. Persons whose last name begins with any letter of the alphabet from M to Z shall renew their license by the thirty-first day of January in each odd-numbered year.
- (C) Persons who fail to submit the renewal fee, completed application, any other required forms, and/or comply with the continuing education requirement specified in rule 4755-23-08 of the Administrative Code, by the thirty-first day of January of the appropriate year shall have their license automatically expire.
  - (1) A license holder whose license expires for failure to renew must submit a reinstatement application in accordance with rule 4755-23-10 of the Administrative Code before the individual may legally practice as a physical therapist or physical therapist assistant in Ohio.
  - (2) A licensee who continues to practice physical therapy or physical therapy assisting with an expired license shall be subject to disciplinary action pursuant to section 4755.47 of the Revised Code.
