To clarify the passing scores required on the TOEFL iBT exam and to clarify that a passing score on the TOEFL iBT is required prior to the Board making the applicant eligible to sit for the NPTE and/or the Ohio Jurisprudence Exam.

of the proposed rule; If the rule type is RESCISSION, NEW or NO CHANGE, then summarize the content of the rule:

Under the current rule, the passing scores required for the reading comprehension and listening comprehension sections are 18 and 21, respectively. The Board has been notified that the correct standards on these two section should be reversed. As a result, the proposed amendment will update the passing standard for reading comprehension to 21 and for listening comprehension to 18.

The rule also proposes to clarify current Board policy to not make an applicant eligible to sit for the NPTE and/or Ohio Jurisprudence Exam until after the applicant has passed the TOEFL iBT exam.

Foreign educated applicants must pay between \$150-\$200 to sit for the TOEFL iBT exam. This fee, which is paid to ETS, varies based on where in the world the applicant sits for the exam. Based on ETS' website, the registration fee to sit in the U.S. is \$180. The fee to sit in the Philippines is \$195 and the fee to sit in India is \$165.

All individuals seeking to practice physical therapy in Ohio must submit an application for licensure. The requirement applies to foreign educated applicants.

If an individual practices physical therapy without a license, they would potentially be subject to civil and criminal penalties.

C.) Does this rule require specific expenditures or the report of information as a condition of compliance? Yes

In addition to all other standard application fees, foreign educated applicants must pay for the credential evaluation and the TOEFL exam. As noted above, the fee for the TOEFL exam ranges from \$150-\$200. The cost for a credential evaluation from FCCPT, one of the primary credentialing organizations, is \$490.
