To add provisions allowing an applicant to submit an electronic application for initial licensure and to add additional requirements for applicants who have been out of practice for more than five years.

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The current rule establishes the manner in which applicants must submit an application for initial licensure. The changes being made add language allowing individuals to also submit an initial licensure application electronically via the Ohio e-License system. The change also specifies that use of the UserID and password assigned by the Board are the sole responsibility of the individual to whom it was issued.

The proposed change also states that applicants for an initial license by exam who graduated from their entry-level OT program more than 5 years before the application date are subject to additional requirements to ensure that they are practicing at entry-level competence. These provisions also apply to applicants for an initial licens by endorsement who have not engaged in the practice of OT for more than 5 years.
