Through the elimination of the pocket ID card, the Board will eliminate costs associated with postage, envelopes, and special security paper. Over the biennium, the Board renews about 1,800 athletic trainers and issues new licenses to about 400 additional individuals. The Board will also potentially forego about \$560 in revenue for duplicate pocket ID cards. The potential decrease in expenditures of \$1,100 exceeds the potential decrease in revenue by about \$540.

Licensees will no longer receive a pocket identification card. Instead of the card, they can print, at no cost, the verification page from the Ohio e-License Center. Licensees who need a replacement card will no longer be required to pay the \$10 duplicate pocket ID card fee. In FY 2009, 28 athletic trainers paid the fee.
