4758-5-08 **Requirements for certification of Ohio prevention specialists** specialist assistants (OCPSA).

- (A) To be certified as a prevention specialist assistant, an individual shall complete the following:
 - (1) Submission of a formal application.
 - (2) Be at least eighteen years of age.
 - (3) Have at least a high school diploma or high school equivalence diploma.
 - (4) At least one hundred hours of compensated or volunteer work, field placement, intern, or practicum experience in alcohol and other drug prevention services.
 - (5) Have at least forty-five hours of prevention related education of which fifty percent shall have been obtained within the last two years <u>and nine hours</u> <u>shall be alcohol and other drug prevention specific</u>. The required content areas with the specific contact hours are as follows:
 - (a) Foundation in chemical dependency use/abuse/dependency (three hours)
 - (b) Foundation in prevention of alcohol and other drug use/abuse/dependency (six hours)
 - (c)(a) Domain I: planning and evaluation (three hours)
 - (d)(b) Domain II: prevention education and skill developmentservice delivery (three hours)

(c) Domain III: communication (three hours)

(e)(d) Domain HHIV: community organization (three hours)

(f)(e) Domain IVV: public policy and environmental change (three hours)

 $(\underline{g})(\underline{f})$ Domain \underline{VVI} : professional growth and responsibility (six<u>fifteen</u> hours)

- (i) Prevention specific ethics education (three hours)
- (ii) Cultural competency (three hours)

(h)(g) The remaining hours may be distributed among these areas at the applicant's discretion.
