## 4758-6-12 Scope of practice for chemical dependency counselors III (LCDC III) with gambling disorder endorsement.

- (A) An individual who holds a chemical dependency counselor III license and a gambling disorder endorsement may do all of the following in addition to those services outlined in rule 4758-6-04 of the Administrative Code:
  - (1) Treat gambling disorder conditions;
  - (2) Diagnose gambling disorder conditions under supervision;
  - (3) Perform treatment planning, assessment, crisis intervention, individual, family, and group counseling, case management, and educational services insofar as those functions relate to gambling disorder;
  - (4) Supervise gambling disorder counseling <del>under the supervision of any of the following:</del>in accordance with section 4758.63 of the Revised Code.
    - (a) An independent chemical dependency counselor or independent chemical dependency counselor-clinical supervisor licensed under Chapter 4758. of the Revised Code;
    - (b) An individual authorized to practice medicine and surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery under Chapter 4731. of the Revised Code;
    - (e) A psychologist licensed under Chapter 4732. of the Revised Code;
    - (d) An individual authorized to practice as a certified nurse practitioner, elinical nurse specialist or a registered nurse licensed under Chapter 4723. of the Revised Code;
    - (e) A professional clinical counselor, independent social worker, or independent marriage and family therapist licensed under Chapter 4757. of the Revised Code.
  - (5) Refer individuals with other conditions to appropriate sources of help.
- (B) An individual holding a chemical dependency counselor III license shall not practice as an individual practitioner.
