The purpose of this rule is to identify agency responsibility in the administration of the Assisted Living HCBS waiver program. Additionally, this rule identifies maxium allowable reimbursement rates for the assisted living HCBS waiver programs as listed in Appendix A. This rule is being amended to establish that the maximum reimbursement for the community transition service is the cumulative total for items purchased or deposit made through the community transition service. The proposed changes to this rule will also make the billing unit used for community transition service consistent with the ODJFS rule that defines the rate setting for Assisted Living services.
