forth the reimbursement rates associated with Ohio Home Care Waiver services. The first hour of Waiver Nursing Services is being reduced by eight percent, and each subsequent hour of Waiver Nursing Services is being reduced by five percent.

ODJFS estimates the changes being implemented by rules 5101:3-46-06, 5101:3-47-06, 5101:3-50-06, and 5101:3-12-06 (for the Ohio Home Care, Transitions MR/DD and Transitions Carve-Out Waivers, and Private Duty Nursing Services, respectively) will decrease annual aggregate Medicaid expenditures by \$8,000,000.

The estimated cost of compliance will vary based on the number of hours of Waiver Nursing Services provided to each consumer. The first hour of Waiver Nursing Services will result in an eight percent decrease in provider revenue, while subsequent hours of Waiver Nursing Services will result in a five percent decrease in provider revenue.
