This rule is being proposed to replace a rescinded rule of the same number that was rescinded as a result of the five year review.

This rule describes the requirements regarding the availability of information, program administration, office operations, and income eligibility verification system information. Changes to the rule include putting the rule into plain language as well as question-and-answer format to improve clarity. Additional changes include:

Language was added to paragraph (A)(1)(b) to require county agencies to display the JFS 00209 "Americans with Disabilities Act as Amended" poster.

The description of fleeing felons and those who have violated a condition of probation or parole was amended in order to align with the new federal regulations.

Paragraphs (A)(7)(b)(iv)(a-d) were stricken. New paragraph (C)(2)(b) references rule 5101:4-2-03 which describes the process to follow to determine if law enforcement is actively seeking an individual.

The term "food assistance" was replaced with "Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)".
