The Ohio Department of Mental Health (ODMH) has reviewed this rule in accordance with section 119.032 ORC and is proposing amendments as a result of the review.

This rule is amended to update term usage: developmental disability for mental retardation; post discharge services for aftercare; co-occurring for dual diagnosis;

mental illness for mental disorder; and community psychiatric supportive treatment for case management. Language is also revised for clarity.

The rule is updated to note the required services which must be either available as needed or provided, and the amount of availability of specified services. It removes the requirement that a social worker providing psycho-social services hold a master's degree and accreditation from a social work accrediting body. The language describing that the hospital shall make reasonable efforts to arrange a post discharge appointment is amended to specify reasonable efforts to make that appointment within two weeks (if needed). This will now align with community mental health providers requirements to provide such appointments within two weeks (if needed) as specified in OAC 5122-26-17 (C)(3).
