OhioMHAS is reviewing the rules in O.A.C. chapter 5122-14 in accordance with the five-year rule review requirements of R.C. 106.03. R.C. 5119.33(A) requires OhioMHAS to inspect and license all hospitals that receive mentally ill persons, except those hospitals managed by OhioMHAS. R.C. 5119.33(B) requires OhioMHAS to adopt rules "prescribing minimum standards for the operation of hospitals for the care and

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treatment of persons with mental illnesses and establishing standards and procedures for the issuance, renewal, or revocation of full, probationary, and interim licenses."

This rule specifies requirements for plans of service and clinical and professional services in OhioMHAS-licensed hospitals, as well as criteria for admissions to and discharges from such hospitals. OhioMHAS is proposing to update the rule to:

- --Reflect that on and after September 30, 2024, Ohio-MHAS licensed beds do not also need to be registered with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) due to the exemption from ODH registration in R.C. 3722.02(C)(4) that was passed by the General Assembly through H.B. 110 of the 134th General Assembly;
- --Specify that psychiatric nursing experience does not, for a nurse hired on or after July 1, 2024, include experience derived from working in a hospital medical unit, emergency department, or other healthcare setting where individuals do not have a primary psychiatric diagnosis.
- --Conform to LSC Rule Drafting Manual drafting standards.

The General Assembly has mandated, through the enactment of R.C. 5119.33(A), that OhioMHAS "inspect and license all hospitals that receive persons with mental illnesses, except those hospitals managed by the department." Pursuant to R.C. 5119.33(B), the General Assembly has mandated that OhioMHAS adopt rules prescribing minimum standards for the operation of hospitals for the care and treatment of persons with mental illnesses and establishing standards and procedures for the issuance, renewal, or revocation of full, probationary, and interim licenses." The rules in O.A.C. chapter 5122-14 prescribe these minimum standards.

The only sanction under the rules in O.A.C. ch. 5122-14 is in O.A.C. 5122-14-05: the department may revoke or refuse to grant or renew a full, probationary, or interim license in accordance with the Ohio Administrative Procedure Act if an inpatient psychiatric service provider or other person engages in an activity listed in paragraph (B) of that rule.
