Home and community-based service waivers: PASSPORT.

- (A) The Ohio department of aging (ODA) is responsible for the daily administration of the preadmission screening system providing options and resources today (PASSPORT) medicaid waiver program. ODA ~~shall~~will administer the waiver pursuant to an interagency agreement with the Ohio department of medicaid in accordance with section 5162.35 of the Revised Code.
- (B) The PASSPORT waiver provides home and community based services (HCBS) to individuals enrolled in the waiver in accordance with rule 5160-31-04 of the Administrative Code.
- (C) The PASSPORT HCBS waiver covered services and eligibility requirements are set forth in Chapter 5160-31 of the Administrative Code.
- (D) The maximum allowable payment rates for PASSPORT HCBS waiver program services are listed in appendix A to this rule.
- (E) PASSPORT HCBS payment ~~must~~will be provided in accordance with paragraphs (A) to (C) of rule 5160-1-60 of the Administrative Code.
