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<u>5160-1-95</u> <u>One-time medicaid provider relief payments: home and community-based providers other than waiver providers.</u>

The department of medicaid (ODM) shall make relief payments available to medicaid home and community-based services providers, as authorized under the "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021," Pub. L. No. 117-2 and Sections 220.20, 220.30, and 220.50 of Amended Substitute House Bill 169 of the 134th General Assembly:

- (A) ODM will make available a one-time payment, in the form of a temporary percentage increase in a provider's payment, to active, non-public providers of the following services:
 - (1) Home health, as defined in rule 5160-12-01 of the Administrative Code.
 - (2) Private duty nursing, as defined in rule 5160-12-02 of the Administrative Code.
 - (3) Nurse assessment and consultation services, as defined in rule 5160-12-08 of the Administrative Code.
 - (4) Behavioral health, as defined in rule 5160-27-01 of the Administrative Code.
 - (5) <u>Durable medical equipment, prostheses, orthoses, and supplies (DMEPOS)</u>
 <u>providers for items and services provided to medicaid recipients in the home and community setting, in accordance with rule 5160-10-01 of the Administrative Code.</u>
- (B) The value of the one-time provider payment will be established in the following manner:
 - (1) Base payment data on February 1, 2022, will be utilized for establishing provider payment amounts.
 - (2) Total value of claims paid during the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 will exclude any provider relief payments previously issued to providers.
 - (3) Only provider claims submitted, paid, and reflected in the ODM management information technology system (MITS) on February 1, 2022, will be used to determine a provider's payment.
 - (4) The value of provider one-time payments will be equivalent to ten per cent of the total value of claims paid for services rendered during the period July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. If ten per cent of the total value of claims is less than one hundred dollars, the provider payment will be one hundred dollars.
