A public hearing will be held by the Office of Ohio Attorney General Dave Yost on Thursday, November 7th at 10:00AM in the Large Conference Room in the Rhodes State Office Tower, 17<sup>th</sup> Floor, 30 E. Broad St., Columbus, OH 43215.

The purpose of the hearing is to solicit comment on Ohio Administrative Code Rules 109:4-1-03, 108:4-1-06, 109:4-1-13, and 109:4-3-14 as they relate to the purposes of the Consumer Protection Section within the Attorney General's office, consumer complaints, severability of rules, and deceptive acts or practices involving insulation.
