The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on the following proposed rules:

Rule 109:4-1-02, titled "Purpose of the office of the Ohio attorney general, consumer protection section." The proposed amended rule clarifies the consumer protection related statutes that are enforced by the attorney general.

Rule 109:4-1-03, titled "Objectives of the office of the Ohio attorney general, consumer protection section." The rule is being amended to clarify the consumer education function of the attorney general.

Rule 109:4-1-05, titled "Organization of the office of the Ohio attorney general, consumer protection section" This rule is being amended to describe the education and community outreach division of the Consumer Protection Section.

Rule 109:4-1-06, titled "Submission of complaints." This rule is being amended to clarify that the Consumer Protection Section will send a complaint form to the complainant if it has been determined inadequate information has been provided.

Rule 109:4-1-10, titled "Description of forms." This rule is being amended to update the forms used by the Consumer Protection Section.

Rule 109:4-3-02, titled "Exclusions and limitations in advertisements." This rule is being amended to clarify what must be disclosed in advertisements.

Rule 109:4-3-14, titled "Insulation." The rule is being amended by removing language no longer necessary.
