

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing will be held by the Ohio Development Services Agency on Friday, January 10, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. in room South A of the Vern Riffe Center, located at 77 South High Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comment on the following proposed rules:

Rule 122-7-01, titled "Notice of meeting." The proposed new rule establishes the method for receiving notice of board and commission meetings staffed by the Ohio Development Services Agency.

Rule 127-1-01, titled "Definitions." The proposed amended rule establishes definitions for the Minority Development Financing Advisory Board.

Rule 127-1-02, titled "Public notice of promulgation of rules." This rule is being rescinded.

Rule 127-1-03, titled "Notice of meeting." The proposed amended rule establishes the procedure for receiving notice of Minority Development Financing Advisory Board meetings.

Rule 127-1-04, titled "Application to the minority business bonding program." The proposed amended rule establishes the procedure for applying to the minority business bonding program.

Rule 122:15-1-01, titled "EDGE bond guarantee program – definitions." The proposed amended rule establishes definitions for the EDGE bond guarantee program.

Rule 122:15-1-02, titled "EDGE bond guarantee program." The proposed amended rule establishes the procedure for participation in the EDGE bond guarantee program.

Rule 122:15-1-03, titled "Ineligibility of principal and surety; loss of program eligibility." The proposed amended rule establishes the circumstances under which a principal or surety is ineligible to participate in the EDGE bond guarantee program.

Rule 122:15-1-04, titled "Bond servicing." The proposed amended rule establishes the requirements related to surety monitoring of bonded contracts.

Rule 122:15-1-05, titled "Payment of loss on DSA guaranteed bond; collection." The proposed amended rule establishes the procedure for submission of claims of loss by a surety to development and the collection process related to those claims.

Rule 122:9-1-01, titled "Community Reinvestment Area Tax Exemption Fee." The proposed amended rule establishes the application fee to enter into an exemption agreement.

Rule 122:9-1-02, titled "Relocation Provisions." The proposed amended rule establishes the requirements related to the relocation of a business of assets or employees from one political subdivision to another when a community reinvestment area is involved.
