

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 119.03, notice is hereby given that the Department of Administrative Services intends to conduct a public hearing for the purpose of amending Ohio Administrative Code Sections 122:1-32-01 and 123:1-32-07.

The proposed to be amended rules deal with the following subject matter:

- 123:1-32-01 Availability and charge of sick leave, vacation leave, and personal leave and compensation for sick leave for employees paid by warrant of the Director of Budget and Management – Deals with the availability, use of, and compensation of sick leave, vacation leave, and personal leave.
- 123:1-32-07 Personal leave with pay and charge of personal leave for employees paid by warrant of the Director of Budget and Management – Deals with the parameters, procedures, and protocols for eligibility, accrual/credit, compensation, use, notification, and limitations for personal leave.

The Department of Administrative Services shall hold a public hearing on the proposed rule amendments on Tuesday, November 20, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. in Room 2793, on the 27th floor of the James A. Rhodes State Office Tower located at 30 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio. At this hearing, any person affected by the rule may appear and be heard in person, by the person's attorney, or both, may present the person's position, arguments, or contentions orally or in writing, offer and examine witnesses, and present evidence that tends to show that the rule, if effectuated, will be unreasonable or unlawful.
