The proposed rules are summarized as the following:

OAC 1301:3-5-10. This proposed rule details the experience requirements needed for boiler operators and steam engineers.

The purpose for this rule is to clarify the language defining the experience requirements necessary to be allowed to sit for the steam engineer, high pressure boiler operator, or low pressure boiler operator examination.
