NOTICE OF INTENTION TO RESCIND AND HOLD A PUBLIC  
HEARING ON ADMINISTRATIVE RULES FOR  
THE DIVISION OF SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION

The Ohio Department of Natural Resources, in accordance with Chapter 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, hereby gives notice of intention to rescind the following rules:

The Department is proposing to rescind these rules because the rules became obsolete when authority over soil and water conservation was transferred by the General Assembly to the Department of Agriculture.
