The Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Oil and Gas Resources Management (Division) will hold a virtual public hearing to accept testimony on proposed changes to Ohio Administrative Code sections 1501:9-1-01, 1501:9-1-02, 1501:9-1-07, and 1501:9-12-01. The hearing will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The public hearing will be held **on November 16, 2020 starting at 1:00 p.m.** The hearing will be held virtually in response to directives from the Ohio Department of Health and Governor Mike DeWine.
