PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

TRANSPORTATION

173-3-06.6 directly regulates the content of provider agreements entered between an area agency on aging (AAA) and a transportation provider when the trip is paid, in whole or in part, with Older Americans Act funds. 173-39-02.13 and 173-39-02.18 directly regulates non-emergency medical transportation and non-medical transportation provided by ODA-certified providers to individuals enrolled in the PASSPORT Program. ODA has reviewed these rules as required under ORC §106.03 and now proposes to rescind, then replace, each rule with a new rule of the same number. Please review the business impact analysis (BIA) for further details.
