NOTICE

ODA will conduct a public hearing to obtain comments concerning ODA's proposed adoption of new rules regarding the **general "housekeeping" matters** of placing rules of one topic into one chapter, splitting two-topic rules with one-topic rule titles into two rules, as required by section 119.03 of the Revised Code. Previously, these same rules were proposed, but as rules under Chapter 173-1 of the Administrative Code. ODA has is now proposing to file them under Chapter 173-2 of the Administrative Code.

ODA will conduct the hearing on **April 28, 2009** in Conference Room A of the Department's offices at 50 W. Broad Street, 9th floor; Columbus, OH 43215. The hearing will begin at **10:00AM** and will continue until all parties in attendance at that time have had an opportunity to provide comment.

ODA is proposing to reorganize the rules that pertain to AAAs so that they appear in one chapter. Additionally, ODA is proposing to split two-topic rules into two one-topic rules. In this reorganization, ODA is not proposing to make any programmatic changes.
