The State Board of Education will hold a public hearing regarding the rule actions listed below, on May 12, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. in room 102 at 25 South Front Street, Columbus, Ohio. • 3301-10-01 School enrollment for victims of domestic violence (Amendment)

The rule was amended to add an exception for those individuals enrolled in the Ohio Secretary of State's Safe At Home address confidentiality program pursuant to ORC 111.43. Individuals enrolled in this program are assigned a substitute address designated by the Secretary of State's Office to use as their home address for school enrollment purposes. The rule was further amended to clarify the requirements for the transfer of credits, grades and attendance.

 3301-24-10 Professional principal licensure for the Bright New Leaders for Ohio Schools program. (Amendment)

Changes to this rule include updated references to Ohio Revised Code 3319.272 where previous citations were to uncodified sections of House Bill 59 of the 130<sup>th</sup> General Assembly. Additionally, the language of this rule has been updated to provide greater clarity and to reference the Bright New Leaders program.

• 3301-24-18 Resident educator license (Amendment)

This rule is being revised to align with grade band changes set forth in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) 3319.22, as amended by Senate Bill 216 of the 132nd General Assembly (SB 216) and to add a licensure option.
