This notice of public hearing announces OOD's intention to rescind rule 3304-2-62 and file a new rule 3304-2-62, and amend rule 3304-1-08 in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code. The reason for filing the proposed rule is to update rule language as part of the five year rule review process.

The purpose of this hearing is to provide the opportunity for any interested person to give testimony for or against this proposed Ohio Administrative Code rule. Testimony for the proposal or against it may be made either at the public hearing or in writing to the Executive Director before the public hearing. Questions about this rule will not be entertained at the public hearing, but may be addressed to the Executive Director either before or after the public hearing.
