The Public Health Council (Council) of the Ohio Department of Health and the Director of the Ohio Department of Agriculture have jointly proposed to amend existing rules 3717-1-01, 3717-1-02.1 through 3717-1-03.5, 3717-1-03.7, 3717-1-04.1, 3717-1-04.2, 3717-1-04.4, 3717-1-04.5, 3717-1-05.1 through 3717-1-05.3, 3717-1-06, 3717-1-06.1, 3717-1-06.4, 3717-1-07.1, 3717-1-08, 3717-1-09, and 3717-1-20; and to adopt new rule 3717-1-08.4 of the Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
