These rules address the Hazardous Waste Management Program. There are two purposes for this rulemaking. First, many of these rules are submitted for their required five-year review under Ohio Revised Code 119. Second, several of these rules are amended to improve the equivalence of the Ohio rule with its federal counterpart provision, as amended. Ohio's hazardous waste rules are required to be equivalent to their federal counterpart provisions. Those federal provisions were changed in the following Federal Registers (FRs), and we are updating the Ohio rules accordingly.

A public hearing on this proposed rulemaking will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will be holding an in-person and virtual public hearing on the rules on Wednesday August 24, 2022, at 10:30am in Conference Room A (Autumn). The inperson hearing will be located at Ohio EPA, Suite 700, 50 W. Town Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. During the hearing, the public may submit written comments on the record about the proposed rules if participating virtually and verbally if participating in person.
